CALL TO ORDER

PUBLIC HEARING

Consideration to Modify Liquor License for Smoking River Brewery, 101 E. Market Street.

Mayor Pro Tem Lockwood opened the public hearing at 7:03 p.m. Town Clerk Cook stated owners Kevin and Hannah Borchard are present, the proposal is to expand the licensed area to include the parking lot for occasional outdoor events such as cornhole tournaments and live music, also for the larger events like Oktoberfest or during the 4th of July which have been held in the past by applying for a festival permit. The applicants have submitted a control plan addressing entrance and exits as well as monitoring the perimeter during the larger events.

Cook said the property has been posted, the public hearing published, all fees have been paid, and staff recommends approval. Cook also requested the applicants notify the Police Dept. when holding larger events.

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Mayor Pro Tem Lockwood asked the Borchard's if the parking lot would be open for alcohol use every day with this new license. Hannah Borchard responded that was not their intent, they would not publicize it is open every day, only on special occasions such as cornhole tournaments and other large events.

Town Clerk Cook stated that Chief Thompson had also looked at the license. Trustee Smith loves the idea; the Brewery does a lot for the community. Mayor Day appreciates Smoking River Brewery as neighbors.

At 7:07 p.m. Mayor Pro Tem Lockwood closed the hearing, Motion to approve was made by Trustee Sizemore. Second by Trustee Browning. All ayes. Motion carried.
